The BI Tournament will apply to this tournament as is incorporated herein and the committee reserve the rights mentioned herein.

Open to all Munster players with the exception of the following;

- Players graded Senior 1 and Senior 2 by Munster Branch.
- Munster U 19 Championship finalists may be deemed ineligible at the discretion of the Munster branch.
- Players U17 on the 31st December 2011

Entries accepted on official entry forms only.

BI clothing rule applies to all Munster competitions – Any color or combination of colors is acceptable. It is recommended that doubles partners wear the same color. Clothing must be racket sports wear – NO football jerseys may be worn in competition. Compliance will save embarrassment on enforcement.

Any player who is eligible to play in the Junior Championships and who may reach the final of a higher grade championship (Snr 1 or Snr 2) can be upgraded to take immediate effect at the discretion of the Munster Branch.

Munster Junior winners to be considered for regrading by the grading committee at the commencement of the following season.

All players must report to the organisers on arrival at the hall.
